RESOLUTION : Resourcing Workers Education.

This Conference Notes:

The increasing vulnerability of workers and their families as a result of the precariousness of work and the continuous reduction of Government spending on education and training and solidarity and development funds devoted to adult continuing and further education and skills.

Therefore IFWEA will support its members like WEA/UK campaigning for

- Work together to challenge the prevailing narrative that it is only young people who need access to education.
- Develop better pathways for students to re-enter learning as needed
- Facilitate collaboration between education providers
- Incentivise employers to encourage and support adult education and training
- Ensure the infrastructure and knowledge of SDIs is fully utilised, maintained and enhanced
- Create mechanisms for long term investment funding in education in the same way as there is investment in big capital projects and infrastructure.

This conference hereby calls on all affiliates to:

Act with IFWEA and its affiliates in targeting all key stakeholders including educators, partners, politicians, policy groups, employers and representative bodies nationally and globally to lobby for workers' education as a means of building democracy, participation, equality and productivity.
